



Postdoctoral Scholar Research Position

Work at USF (Job #32578)

Overview

The Department of Psychology in the College of Arts & Sciences at University of South Florida invites applications for a two-year Postdoctoral Research position (non-remote) in clinical psychology (w/ option for a third year). This appointee will assist with grant funded research under the direction of Drs. Robert C. Schlauch (USF-Tampa) and Stephen A. Maisto (Syracuse University) by managing a NIAAA-funded project examining recovery from Alcohol Use Disorder (RECOVERY study). Opportunities to conduct research/publish and/or complete clinical hours for those seeking licensure also available.

Qualifications

The candidate for the position must have a Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from an APA or PCSAS accredited program. Recent Ph.D. graduates or scholars who have completed their M.S. or M.P.H. and are in the process of pursuing a Ph.D. are also encouraged to apply. A minimum of three years of relevant research-related experience is preferred, although this experience can come from years spent as a graduate or undergraduate research assistant. Experience with implementing and/or managing NIH grants is also preferred.

Job-specific qualifications

Preference will be given to candidates with outstanding written and oral communication skills, experience working with and/or managing a research team, evidence of successful scientific writing in the form of peer-reviewed manuscripts and/or grant applications, proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite, EndNote (or a similar reference manager), SPSS and/or other statistical software (e.g., R, STATA, SAS), and experience in database management and statistical analysis. The candidate must also have the communication skills and cross-cultural abilities to work with diverse groups of students, colleagues, and community members. Responsibilities will include: (1) managing participants enrolled in the RECOVERY study, (2) drafting IRB amendments, maintaining IRB protocols, and ensuring proper execution of IRB approved standardized operating procedures for the RECOVERY study, (3) supervising undergraduate and graduate research assistants, (4) preparing progress reports to NIAAA, (5) maintaining the RECOVERY project's database and executing data analyses, and (6) assisting with manuscript preparation and submission as a co-author and first author.
